India's food and grocery market is expected to touch USD 482 billion by 2020. India's food industry stands at USD 39.71 billion. It is expected to grow at a Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 11% to USD 65.4 billion by 2018. Indian food and grocery market is the 6th largest in the world with retail contributing 70% sales. Indian food processing industry accounts for 32% of the country's total food market, it is ranked 5th in terms of production, consumption, export and expected growth.

Indian food processing industry contributes around 14% of manufacturing Gross Domestic Product (GDP), 13% of India's exports and 6% of total industrial investment.
